#### background

- scientist (physics) to me, computer is a tool
- need to do calculations and simulations (Basic, Fortran, Octave, CASs)
- ... and text editing, Tex article preparation, & the usual Internet usage (email, etc.)

# history

- used DrDOS to mid 90s then saw walls closing in
- initially rejected OS/2, because IBM's ads turned me off
- but Windows was such a joke, I went back to get a closer look at OS/2
- started with OS/2 Warp 3 Connect

### predilections

- am keyboard-centric avoid rodents
- find white backgrounds hard on eyes
- want to customize apps to my way of working
- value robustness over 'cutting edge'

## the move to Mac – theory

- Unix-based: it's solid & secure
- just acquired Intel-based hardware (2006)
- can run eCS under Parallels virtual machine
- handles latest software and existing s.w.
- ... get best of both worlds !

### the move to Mac – reality

- Mac OS X is rock-solid... as long as you don't try to customize it
- the Mac is mouse-centric
- all default backgrounds are bright white
- lots of problems with Parallels for Mac

#### problems with Parallels, ver 2.5

- most USB thumb drives didn't work

   initially no clipboard transfer to Mac
   VM had memory leak, died after ~1 day
- after initial help to get registered, neither I nor Apple tech could get any Tech Support
- wrote letter to Nova pres., got results...

#### ... personal support

- interacted with Dmitry Romanov very responsive, promised reg. for fixed prod.
- got clipboard visible from Mac
- discovered mem leak due to interaction with Mac app called 'Zooom' (focus follows mouse)
- but VM still invariably froze after ~1.5 days

## ... then it was gone

- Par. ver 4 supposed to be complete re-write
- came out early '09 solved VM freeze prob, but introduced others:
  - frozen clock
  - no clipboard transfers
  - no USB at all
- finally asked for new reg. learned D.M.
   was leaving Parallels, go to Tech Supp ...

## **latest Parallels for Mac**

- after various hurdles, got new registration for ver 4
- continuing feedback, told to communicate directly with ver 4 Product Manager
- no one ever got a response
   no fixes for OS/2 after initial release
   no longer any mention of OS/2 in manuals

### other virtualization s.w. on Mac

- VMware Fusion: no support, no success
- VirtualBox:
  - no success with eCS 1.2r
  - got thru eCS 2.0 rc6a install, but phase I always aborted with error msg 'Unexpected condition' 0x1604 'SEINST install failed'

# using Parallels Desktop for Mac v.4

- latest build is 3844
- regular guest is eCS 1.2r, about 2 yrs old
- + doesn't freeze
  - + networks to Mac, eCS PC, Internet, printer+ seamless pointer movement
- no clipboard sharing
  - no USB
  - no clock

## using Parallels – cont'd

successfully installed from .ISO files

- new copy of eCS 1.2r

- eCS 2.0 rc6a

- with no USB, how to enter registration info? answer: Chuck's 'floppy.img'
- same pluses & minuses as original

# creating & running a VM

- will bring up Parallels, step thru creation of new virtual machine
- ... look over VM configuration pages
- ... but not go thru lengthy eCS custom installer
- brief look at running eCS VM

#### summary

- if you like the Mac 'personality' or know how to shape it, it's a good choice
- Parallels works with limitations, support for OS/2 & eCS doubtful
- VirtualBox still evolving, may have a brighter future
