Fact Sheet 1 – For foreign visitors

I have heard serious concerns from some of our past attendees and speakers about attending Warpstock in the USA. I recognize that some USA policies have changed after the November 2024 election.

I'm doing my best to keep Warpstock away from politics. I'm certainly not trying to argue with people about that. I'm just saying that supporting Warpstock neither endorses nor opposes any USA policies. Further, Warpstock is not intrinsically political. The current USA administration has never expressed a view about OS/2.

I'm not qualified to give travel advice. I did a quick search on line and found these tidbits.

The Visa Waiver Program (VWP) is a program of the United States government that allows nationals of specific countries to travel to the United States for tourism, business, or while in transit for up to 90 days without having to obtain a visa.

All incoming passengers who intend to take advantage of the Visa Waiver Program are required to apply for a travel authorization through the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) online before departure to the United States, preferably at least 72 hours (3 days) in advance. This requirement was announced on June 3, 2008 and is intended to bolster U.S. security by pre-screening participating VWP passengers against terrorist or no-fly lists and databases.

Upon application for entry to the United States, you should expect thorough screening procedures at airports and other ports of entry. Your identity and the validity of your visa will be checked against law enforcement databases. You will be fingerprinted and photographed upon entry. You may also be subject to intensive questioning about your immigration status, travel history, the purpose of your visit, background, employment and other issues. This could include a search of your electronic devices.

Warpstock 2021 – Event plan

We will be connecting to Martin's console and switching between us. If you want, you can show slides to test that. Basically, we won't be presenting anything. We're just verifying that each of us can connect as we will expect to do it at Warpstock.

This is the first time Warpstock has been on-line only. In the past, we have offered on-line as a view into the in-person event, and the event was planned with sessions and breaks.

This year, the event is on-line only. To better adapt to the on-line format, the timing of sessions will be more fluid, and much faster. An in person event leads to lots of interaction between participants and with the presenter. On-line has none of that, and the participants have every distraction available to them at home.

For this reason, the tempo of the on-line event is different. While I want presenters to have all the time they need to include the material they want to present, I'd like the presentations to keep audience attention. I am scheduling 15 minutes for most presentations, but that is due to limitations of our web calendar. Take the time you need to make a good presentation.

The first four presentations will be before the break, and the second will be after the break. Each presentation will be followed by a brief call for Q and A and then move right into the next presentation.

There will be time for chat after the second block of presentations. I'm hoping to wind up the whole show in 3 hours, including break time.

In person presentations will have a projector available for slides and/or your computer.

If you are a remote presenter, live input can come to us via most of the popular streaming services (Zoom, Google Hangouts, etc.). Please let us know in advance so that we may be prepared to receive your broadcast.

The standard presentation length is 45 minutes. There will be a question and answer session after each presentation, and a moderator will ask questions posed by on-line viewers.

If you have a video, please submit it ahead of time. We will feed it in and then you can answer questions afterward.
