


Starfire Titan: An IT Skills Delivery System


- Control over heterogeneous and disparate systems


Where Does Titan Fit Into My Organization?

Starfire Titan: Architecture





The Titan Controller

- Repository: A relational database containing Enterprise Objects, Tasks, Activities, etc.
- Controller: Manages Jobs and agent communications
- Launch Engine: Invokes the Controller to launch Activities



Titan Activities

- Encapsulated skills as step-by-step instructions required to accomplish any given task
- Written in TitanScript (functional language)
- Result of activity launch: Job Creation
- Jobs contain transactions




Titan Agents

- The agent is a Java daemon that runs on each Titan-managed system
- Executes Job Transactions as they are dispatched from the Controller
- Transactions are the atomic unit of work carried out on Titan-managed systems
- All executed Transactions are logged and shipped back to the Controller for Repository update




