Requirements 1

- Be able to take the video
 - Camcorder
 - Digital Camera
 - Video Capture
- Transfer the video to computer
 - Download
 - File transfer
 - Capture from online

Requirements 2

- Software
 - Transfer or input
 - Change format
 - Edit the raw footage - image
 - Edit the sound
 - Splice elements into cohesive structure
 - Add special effects
 - Add sound or music

Requirements 3

- Software (continued)
 - Add titles
 - Add menus
 - Assemble and organize all segments
 - Prepare a DVD image or playable file
 - Play the final product
 - Burn the final version to media

Process 1

- Scripted or unscripted (There is always a script.)
- Shoot the images or create them
- Assemble raw images
- Record or obtain audio portion (line or after shoot)
- Combine audio and video
- Edit the raw images to get what you planned
- Screen and edit some more

Process 2

- Repeat the last three steps
- Shoot/create extra images as needed
- Repeat the last five steps to polish
- Create title and menu images as required
- Assemble all final components for video
- Review and edit results
- Create a master for duplication or distribution

eComStation Software

- Mplayer/smplayer – player or viewer
- QDVDAuthor – title and menu creator
- MainActor/2 beta – editor and sequencer
- FFMPGCA – format converter
- Qeven – video project manager
- May be some others that I have missed

Image Transfer from Camcorder

- May be problematic in eComStation
- Older camcorders using tape often require firewire
 - No firewire driver
- Harddrive camcorders use USB
 - Great except the harddrives are formatted by camera
- Memory card camcorders use USB or USB adapters
 - Once again formatted by the camera

Editing Video

- eComStation software is weak at this process
- Slideshow can be turned into a video with some effort

Assembling the Raw Footage

- With some considerable effort it may be done

Creating Distribution Media

- If you are able to package together all of the elements into a file burning VCD or DVD can be accomplished with RSJ or one of the other CD/DVD burning programs.

Conclusion

- At the present time there is no one program or package of programs that will run in eComStation and do all of the tasks necessary.
- Chances of future development will require an adequate demand for such a program.
- To readily accomplish the task of creating a video will require the use of another operating system that has the requisite software available.
